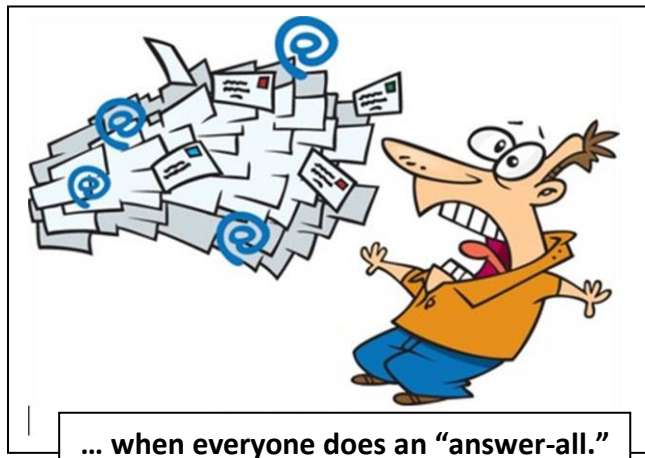

RECIPE OF THE MONTH!

Creamy Egg Salad



This egg salad is the creamiest and smoothest I have ever tried. It is intended to be used in a sandwich, but I couldn't help but eat a solo serving. Egg-cellent side for your leftover Easter ham.



Ingredients:

- 2 Tablespoons butter, room temperature
- 3 oz cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 Tablespoon Mayo (or more if desired)
- 2 Tablespoons celery, minced
- 1 teaspoon onion, grated or minced
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 6 hard-boiled eggs, finely chopped or squished with a fork.

Directions:

- In a medium bowl, cream together butter and cream cheese until smooth.
- Stir in celery, mayo, onion, sugar, lemon juice, salt, and pepper until well blended.
- Add eggs and mix well.
- Serve on bread or croissants.












Susan's Notes:

- Chop your celery and onion very fine, otherwise you will experience the crunch of those vegetables instead of the creaminess of the whole salad.
- Don't be shy about adding other ingredients for a flavor-pop. Try dill pickle relish, paprika, bacon, or horseradish – let your tastebuds be your guide.
