As of December 10th, hundreds of people had already made the trek through the Twinkle at the Track's holiday light display at the Motorsports Park. Visitors had spent a warm and pleasant time with family and friends while gathered around the numerous fire pits at the Santa's village area. Children and adults lined up to get their picture taken with Santa Claus and his C8 Christmas delivery sled. A great deal of Christmas spirit had already been created around this scene. All that fun and cheer changed overnight due to the destruction that Mother Nature unleashed with her fury in the Bowling Green area.

The good news in all of the damage at the Motorsports Park was that the impact was limited to property damage with no injuries or loss of life. Very sadly, that can't be said for other areas of Bowling Green and the State of Kentucky.



The building housing a large fleet of new C8s which were waiting in line for Museum Delivery to their new owners was heavily damaged. Some of those Corvettes

sustained various amounts of damage as well. Fortunately, the flow of C8 deliveries at the NCM has been able to continue. Major damage was done to the Holley Building, where CLBG held our Christmas party just 6

days prior to the tornados. No estimate has been released on the build-back time frame at the track.

# RECIPE OF THE MONTH! Spicy Shrimp Salad



I traveled all the way South of the Border (in my head) to bring you this recipe. It is neither carb nor sugar heavy, and I think it makes a great contrast to all the holiday foods I have been consuming. This is from a cookbook that has been on my shelf for a very long time, although I had not tried this dish until now.



The name says "spicy", but you can totally control how spicy by selecting a milder chili or taco sauce.

#### Ingredients:

- 1 lb cooked peeled Shrimp
- Juice of one Lime
- 3 Tomatoes
- 1 ripe but firm Avocado
- 2 Tbsp hot Chili Sauce (not tabasco sauce) You can also use hot Taco Sauce.
- 1 tsp Sugar
- 2/3 cup Sour Cream
- 2 Bibb Lettuce leaves
- Salt and Pepper, to taste

#### Directions:

- Combine shrimp, lime juice, salt and pepper in bowl. Toss lightly then leave to marinate.
- Prepare the tomatoes:
  - Skin the tomatoes: Cut a cross in bottom of each, cover with boiling water and set for 5 minutes. Move tomatoes to a cold-water bath, then skin completely
  - Remove the seeds from tomatoes, then cut the flesh into ½ inch cubes.
- Add the tomato cubes to the shrimp.
- Cut the avocado into 1/2 inch chunks and combine with the shrimp mix.
- Combine the sour cream, hot sauce and sugar in small bowl. Fold the sour cream mix into the shrimp.
- Line a bowl with the lettuce leaves and fill with the shrimp mixture.
- Cover and chill for 1 hour.
