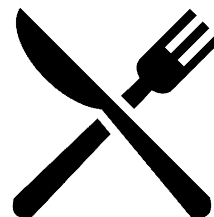
# RECIPE OF THE MONTH!

## Cornbread - Jiffy Mix Fix



I confess – I’ve been browsing the internet in search of recipes. Again. You know my preferences by now: easy, fast, tasty, and hopefully a new twist. This certainly meets those criteria.

I love taking a product that I have used forever and discovering ways to improve or at least change it up. For another example of this, check out the recipe on CLBG.us called “Better Boxed Brownies”



### Ingredients:

- 7 Tablespoons butter
- 1 1/5 cup buttermilk
- 3 eggs
- 1/4 cups sugar
- 2 Boxes Jiffy Cornbread Mix

### Ingredients for the Glaze:

- 1 Tablespoon melted butter
- 1 Tablespoon honey

### Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- Put the 7 Tbsp butter in your 10” cast iron skillet and place in the oven until butter is melted.
- In large bowl, whisk Jiffy mixes and sugar together.
- In separate bowl, whisk 3 eggs, then add the buttermilk to the eggs and whisk until combined.
- Add milk and egg mix to the dry ingredients, mix well until combined.
- Pour the melted butter from the skillet into the batter and mix/whisk until smooth.
- Pour batter into the skillet and bake for 40 to 45 minutes, testing center with a toothpick.
- Remove from oven, mix your melted butter and honey for the glaze, and brush it on the top of the bread.
- Let set for about 15 minutes, then serve.



- Be sure to bake at **350 degrees**, not the higher temp used on the Jiffy Box recipe.
